Create a diorama for any one of the different climate zone.	Write a poem about a plant or an animal that lives in any of the different biomes.	Research and create a fact file for an animal that lives in any of the major biomes. E.g polar bear - desert Whale - aquatic	Create a poster on the different climate zones.
Find out what part bees play in the life cycle of a plant and draw a poster or write an explanation showing what you have found out.
