Achievements Assembly is fortnightly and takes place on a Wednesday morning. It would be really helpful if the children are prepped for this and ready with certificates/medals/photos etc. Our first Achievements Assembly of the year will be next week on **18th September**. Open the Book is a storytelling project where Bible stories are shared with children in a fun and interactive way. A small team of volunteers visit St Minver School fortnightly to present a 10 minute scripted Bible story in a school assembly. The storytelling teams are made up of trained and safely recruited volunteers from local churches and organisations. Their aim is to share Bible stories with children in an accessible and enjoyable way for those of all faiths and none, and to tell Bible stories in ways that enable children to engage imaginatively with the text.
